## How does street design affect health, safety and access to schools?

The public is invited to a free workshop to learn about street design, how it affects the safety and health of school children, and how streets can be transformed to make communities even better places. National traffic-calming expert Dan Burden will make a presentation on best practices for creating safe access to schools, with a focus on street and intersection design, traffic-calming practices, smoother flow for drop-off/pick-up, posted speed limits versus “design” speeds, and school access for cars, buses, cyclists and pedestrians.
